

Nymphoides peltata

Common name:
Yellow floating heart

Origin:
Europe, Japan, China, and India

Key features:
Floating leaf plant

Stems: Branching stems spread over water's surface

Leaves: Floating leaves are round and heart-shaped at base, paired at each node

Flowers: Flowers are bright yellow on long peduncles with 5 fringed petals

Fruits/Seeds: Seeds are flat and oval and are in capsules

Reproduction: Seeds and rhizomes

Easily confused species:

Little floating heart: *Nymphoides cordata*

Yellow water lily: *Nuphar variegata*

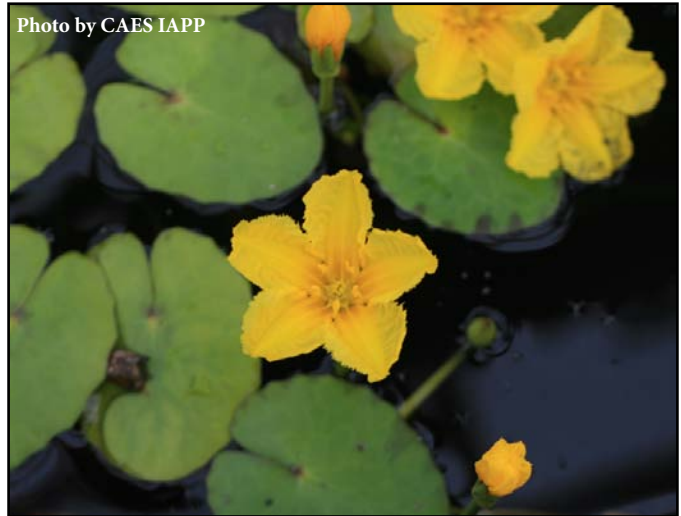
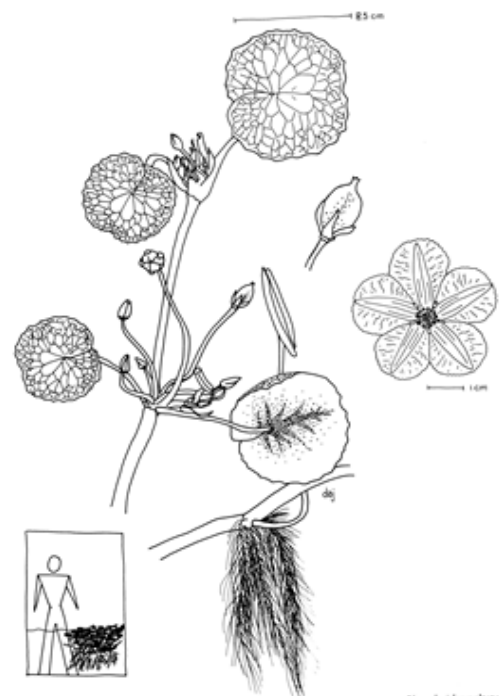
